

1 ENGROSSED SENATE

7 An Act relating to the Office of Management and
8 Enterprise Services; requiring that certain
9 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes in
10 certain amounts for certain purposes; directing
11 certain transfer; providing certain limitation on
12 amount of transfer; providing lapse dates; and
13 requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
16 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040
17 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
18 Million Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$1,920,000.00) shall
19 be used to provide for the Pay for Success program. Of that amount,
20 seventy-five percent (75%) shall be utilized by the Office in equal
21 amounts for municipalities of the state with populations of three
22 hundred fifty thousand (350,000) or more as determined by the latest
23 Federal Decennial Census.

24 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040

1 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
2 Fifteen Million Eight Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Six Hundred
3 Sixty-six Dollars (\$15,847,666.00) shall be used to provide for
4 Device-as-a-service augmentation.

5 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
6 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040
7 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
8 Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used for
9 the study of human trafficking performed by the Oklahoma Commission
10 on the Status of Women.

11 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
12 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040
13 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
14 Thirty-five Million Seven Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand Dollars
15 (\$35,737,000.00) shall be used for Service Oklahoma implementation.

16 SECTION 5. The Director of the Office of Management and
17 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies from the FY-22
18 appropriation made to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board in an
19 amount outlined in Section 100 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of
20 the 1st Session of the 58th Legislature for costs associated with a
21 water study to the Phase II Arbuckle-Simpson Hydrology Study
22 Revolving Fund (235 Fund) created pursuant to Section 1085.7C of
23 Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Phase II of the Arbuckle-
24 Simpson Hydrology Study except that the cumulative amounts

1 transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amounts of equal monthly
2 allotments of the appropriation made to the Oklahoma Water Resources
3 Board.

4 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be
7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
8 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
9 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
10 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
13 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23 and not required to pay
17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
20 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
