14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-102.1, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 7-102.1. A. Prior to the day of the election, it shall
17	be the duty of the secretary of the county election board to prepare
18	for each precinct where an election is to be held in the county, a
19	written or electronic precinct registry which shall contain
20	information on all registered voters in the precinct as prescribed
21	by the Secretary of the State Election Board. The information which
22	is or would be contained in such a registry shall at all times be
23	public information.

1 B. The Secretary of the State Election Board may authorize the 2 use of electronic precinct registries by one or more county election 3 boards. Subject to available funding, the Secretary may purchase 4 any equipment and software necessary to implement an electronic 5 precinct registry system. The Secretary shall promulgate rules as necessary to implement, operate and maintain security for a system 6 of electronic precinct registries. 7 AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-117, is SECTION 2. 8 9 amended to read as follows: 10 Section 7-117.
