8 A Joint Resolution disapproving in whole certain
subject matter standards adopted by the State Board
9 of Education; instructing adoption of new standards;
and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-103.6a-1 of Title 70 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to review all
14 subject matter standards and revisions to the standards adopted by
15 the State Board of Education, and approve the standards, disapprove
16 the standards in whole or in part, amend the standards in whole or
17 in part, or disapprove the standards in whole or in part with
18 instructions to the State Board of Education; and

19 WHEREAS, on March 24, 2022, the State Board of Education
20 submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
21 President Pro Tempore of the Senate the adopted Oklahoma Academic
22 Standards for Health and Oklahoma Academic Standards for Physical
23 Education.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
2 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Academic Standards for Health and
4 Oklahoma Academic Standards for Physical Education adopted by the
5 State Board of Education and submitted to the Speaker of the House
6 of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate on
7 March 24, 2022, do not reflect the intent of the Legislature and are
8 hereby disapproved in whole. The Legislature, in accordance with
9 subsection C of Section 11-103.6a-1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
10 Statutes, instructs the State Board of Education to adopt, by no
11 later than July 1, 2022, Oklahoma Academic Standards for Health and
12 Oklahoma Academic Standards for Physical Education in accordance
13 with Enrolled Senate Bill No. 89 enacted by the 1st Session of the
14 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

15 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute
16 copies of this resolution to the Governor, the State Board of
17 Education, the State Department of Education, and the editor of "The
18 Oklahoma Register".
