A Resolution recognizing the first week of May as
Teacher Appreciation Week; and honoring Oklahoma
educators.

in the classroom; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma educators teach more than 700,000 students
enrolled in Pre-K through 12th grade; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma teachers faced numerous hurdles during the
COVID-19 pandemic and diligently served their students through all
of the obstacles thrown their way; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma teachers mold future citizens through guidance
and education; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma teachers spend countless hours preparing
lessons, evaluating progress, counseling and coaching students and
performing community service; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma students are positively impacted by their
teachers every day, leaving a lasting impact on their lives.
