An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 509, which relates to
the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967; updating list
of penal institutions; adding facilities; and
providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Prisons and reformatories

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 509, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 509. A. The Oklahoma Department of Corrections is
authorized to maintain the following facilities in Oklahoma:

"Bill" Johnson Correctional Center shall be located east of in Alva in Woods County, State of Oklahoma; and the Washita Valley Correctional Center shall be located at Pauls Valley in Garvin County, State of Oklahoma; and said institutions and community corrections centers are hereby established within the Department. Said.~~

B. ~~The~~ Department shall be the legal successor of and, except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967, shall have the powers and duties vested by law in the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in all matters relating to penal institutions, heretofore or hereafter established by the Department, which institutions and community corrections centers shall be under the administrative direction and control of the Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
