A Concurrent Resolution relating to the oil and gas
industry.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma hereby declares that the oil and gas industry is a vital part of the economy of the State of Oklahoma and the state, and those companies that do business by and through the state in the interest of the state's economic policy should not boycott the oil and gas industry; and

WHEREAS, the state should not enter into a contract with a company unless the company submits a written certification that the company is not currently engaged in a boycott, in any manner, of the oil and gas industry that constitutes an integral part of business conducted or sought to be conducted with the state; and

WHEREAS, the state should not adopt a procurement, investment or other policy that has the effect of inducing or requiring a person to boycott the oil and gas industry or a person doing business with the oil and gas industry; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Secretary of State should approve contracts or may waive application of this resolution on any contract with any state agency if the Secretary determines that compliance is not practicable.
