9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to crimes and punishments;  
11 prohibiting unlawful uses of drones; making violation  
12 a misdemeanor; providing exceptions; providing for  
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1743 of Title 21, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. No person using an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) or drone,  
19 as defined by the Federal Aviation Administration, shall, except as  
20 authorized by law:

21 1. Trespass onto private property or into airspace within four  
22 hundred (400) feet above ground level with the intent to subject  
23 anyone to eavesdropping or other surveillance;

1        2. Install on private property, without the consent of the  
2 owner or lessee, any device for observing, photographing, recording,  
3 amplifying, or broadcasting sounds or events on such property, or  
4 use any such unauthorized installation;

5        3. Intentionally use a drone to photograph, record, or  
6 otherwise observe another person in any place where the person has a  
7 reasonable expectation of privacy; or

8        4. Intentionally land a drone on the lands or waters that are  
9 the private property of another without the consent of the owner or  
10 lessee.

11        B. A person who violates this act is guilty of a misdemeanor.  
12 Paragraph 3 of subsection A of this section shall not apply to a  
13 drone operator operating a drone for a bona fide business or bona  
14 fide government purpose who unintentionally or incidentally  
15 photographs, records, or otherwise observes another person in a  
16 private place, nor shall it apply to a designated emergency  
17 management worker operating a drone within the scope of his or her  
18 duties of employment. Paragraph 4 of subsection A shall not apply  
19 to the landing of a drone required in the interest of safety or  
20 otherwise in an emergency to avoid collision with a person or  
21 property.

22        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
