9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to state parks; prohibiting occupying
11 a reserved campsite; prohibiting entering a state
12 park where an entry fee is required; setting
13 administrative fine; providing for collection and
14 deposit of certain fines; providing for codification;
15 and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2217A of Title 74, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. No person shall:

21 1. Physically occupy a campsite identified as "Reserved" by
22 Department staff or by the park reservation system, or fail to
23 vacate a campsite within a reasonable time after being notified of
24 the campsite's reserved status by Department staff; or

1 2. Enter an area of a state park that is identified as an area
2 requiring payment of an entry fee without having first paid the
3 entry fee or being a valid park entry passholder for the date of
4 entry.

5 B. Any violation of the provisions of this section may be
6 punishable by an administrative fine not exceeding:

- 7 1. Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a first offense;
- 8 2. One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a second offense; and
- 9 3. Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for any third or
10 subsequent offense.

11 C. All monies collected pursuant to this section shall be
12 deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
13 Revolving Fund.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
