10 Senator James Inhofe Interchange; amending Section
11 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L. 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020,
12 Section 1698.296), which relates to the Councilwoman
13 Avalon Reese Memorial Highway; modifying name of
14 certain memorial highway; providing for codification;
15 and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located
approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be
designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert
James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located
2 approximately one-half (0.5) mile north of West Madison Avenue near
3 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the
4 "U.S. Army PFC Keith N. Cantrell Memorial Bridge". The Department
5 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
6 that name to be placed on the bridge.

7 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of
11 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of
12 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be
13 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr., and Michael Rogers Memorial
14 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
15 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

16 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located
20 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal
21 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran
22 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
23 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
24 bridge.

1 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County beginning at the
5 intersection of Newman Road then extending north to the intersection
6 of Commerce Street in the City of Commerce shall be designated as
7 "South Mickey Mantle Boulevard". The Department of Transportation
8 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
9 placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Deep Rock Road and
14 extending north three (3) miles in Payne County shall be designated
15 as the "Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
17 name to be placed on the highway.

18 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over
22 South 129th Avenue on State Highway 51, also known as the Broken
23 Arrow Expressway, in Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, shall be designated
24 as the "Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over Lee
7 Boulevard on Interstate 44 in the City of Lawton in Comanche County
8 shall be designated as the "Maj. Charles E. Stiles Memorial Bridge".
9 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
10 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
15 Highway 28A beginning at the intersection of State Highway 66 near
16 the Town of Foyil extending east to the intersection of Interstate
17 44 in Rogers County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H.
18 Honeycutt Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
19 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
20 the highway.

21 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The bridge crossing over the Washita River on U.S. Highway 62
2 located three-tenths (0.3) of a mile east of the H.E. Bailey
3 Turnpike near Chickasha in Grady County shall be designated as the
4 "Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher Memorial Bridge". The Department of
5 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
6 name to be placed on the bridge.

7 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge crossing
11 over the Washita River on State Highway 8 north of the city of
12 Anadarko in Caddo County shall be designated as the "Joe W. McBride
13 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
14 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
15 bridge.

16 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The section of the U.S. Highway 70 Bypass beginning just south
20 of U.S. 70 and extending south and west to the intersection of
21 McLean Drive on the west side of the city of Durant in Bryan County
22 shall be designated as the "Deputy Jarid Taylor Memorial Highway".
23 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
24 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 78 beginning just north of the
5 intersection of State Highway 22 extending northwesterly to the
6 eastern municipal limits of Milburn in Johnston County shall be
7 designated as the "USAF Capt. Nick Karpis Vietnam Veteran Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the north municipal
14 limits of Mill Creek in Johnston County then extending northerly to
15 the Murray County line shall be designated as the "Sgt. Clyde Runyan
16 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
17 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
18 highway.

19 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The causeway over Old Spiro Lake on State Highway 9 in LeFlore
23 County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Maj. Marvail Lewis Memorial
24

1 Causeway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the causeway.

3 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the intersection of
7 E1040 Road extending northerly to the intersection of E. 128th
8 Street in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "County
9 Commissioner Roy Rains Memorial Highway". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the intersection of
16 U.S. Highway 75 extending east two (2) miles to the intersection of
17 N. Memorial Road in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "PFC
18 Richard Tafoya Gurule Memorial Highway". The Department of
19 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
20 name to be placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The section of State Highway 9 beginning at the intersection of
2 Interstate 35 extending west to the intersection of U.S. Highway 62
3 in McClain County shall be designated as the "Capt. David Arthur
4 Peters Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
5 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
6 the highway.

7 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.326 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The intersection of State Highway 66 and Banner Road in Canadian
11 County shall be designated as the Ray Davis Memorial Intersection.
12 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
13 markers bearing that name to be placed at the intersection.

14 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.327 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 25 beginning at the intersection of
18 State Highway 2 extending east to the western municipal limits of
19 Bluejacket in Craig County shall be known as the "Robert L. Horton
20 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
21 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
22 highway.

1 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.328 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 3 West beginning at the west side
5 of the State Highway 19 interchange extending west to the
6 intersection of County Road 1510 in Pontotoc County shall be known
7 as the "John L. Hayden Memorial Highway". The Department of
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
9 name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.329 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
14 Highway 53 beginning at the intersection of Midway Road extending
15 east through the community of Milo to the intersection of Woodford
16 Road in Carter County shall be known as the "Creede Speake Jr.
17 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
19 highway.

20 SECTION 23. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.330 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over Honey Creek Pass located on Interstate 35 just
24 south of Exit 51 in Murray County shall be known as the "W.D. Bill

1 Amis Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 bridge.

4 SECTION 24. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.331 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of State Highway 199 from the western municipal
8 limits of Dickson to the eastern municipal limits of Ardmore shall
9 be known as the "SSG Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway". The
10 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
11 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 25. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.332 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge crossing over US Highway 69 Business located on US
16 Highway 69 at the south edge of McAlester in Pittsburg County shall
17 be known as the "Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge". The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
19 name to be placed on the bridge.

20 SECTION 26. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.333 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of U.S.
24 Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of Broadway Avenue in

1 Ardmore extending north to the intersection of State Highway 142 in
2 Carter County shall be known as the "Martin Dyer Memorial Highway".
3 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers
4 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 27. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
6 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.334 of Title 69, unless there
7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of U.S. Highway 169 beginning at the intersection of
9 East 81st Street South extending north to the south side of State
10 Highway 51 in Tulsa County shall be known as the "Sgt. Craig Johnson
11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
13 highway.

14 SECTION 28. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.335 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the interchange of
18 Interstate 40 and Douglas Boulevard located in Midwest City in
19 Oklahoma County shall be known as the "U.S. Senator James Inhofe
20 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
21 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at the
22 interchange."

1 SECTION 29. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L.
2 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1698.296), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1698.296 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business
5 beginning at West 23rd Street South extending north to the
6 intersection of West Southside Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in
7 Muskogee County shall be designated as the "Councilwoman Avalon
8 ~~Reese~~ Reece Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
9 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
10 placed on the highway.

11 SECTION 30. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
