From the funds appropriated to the Office of 20 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session 21 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Five 22 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used to increase 23 the funding of the Community Based Youth Services Division of the 24 Office of Juvenile Affairs above the actual expenditure levels for

the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. This funding shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing funding.

SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
