7                                   AS INTRODUCED

8                   An Act relating to sunset; amending 73 O.S. 2021,  
9                   Section 83.1, which relates to the Capitol-Medical  
10                  Center Improvement and Zoning Commission; re-creating  
11                  the Commission; and modifying termination date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13                  SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           73 O.S. 2021, Section 83.1, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15                  Section 83.1 A. There is hereby re-created to continue until  
16 July 1, ~~2022~~ 2025, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law, a  
17 Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning Commission to exercise  
18 the functions and perform the duties hereinafter prescribed.

19                  B. The Commission shall be composed of eleven (11) members as  
20 follows:

21                  1. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
22 Services or his or her designee, who shall be ex officio chair of  
23 the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning Commission;

1           2. The Director of the Transportation Commission or his or her  
2 designee;

3           3. The President of the University of Oklahoma or his or her  
4 designee;

5           4. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
6 Senate;

7           5. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
8 Representatives;

9           6. The Chair of the Planning Commission of Oklahoma City or his  
10 or her designee;

11           7. The Chair of the Long-Range Capital Planning Commission; and

12           8. Two members of the Commission appointed by the Governor,  
13 with the advice and consent of the State Senate, for four-year  
14 staggered terms with one term expiring on January 31 of each even-  
15 numbered year.

16           C. One of the two members shall be appointed upon the  
17 recommendation of the Citizens' Advisory Committee. The Commission  
18 is authorized to appoint and hire a Director, who shall serve as the  
19 chief administrative officer of the Commission, and other necessary  
20 personnel. The Attorney General of the State of Oklahoma shall be  
21 the legal advisor to the Commission in the same capacity as he or  
22 she is to other boards and commissions.

23           D. At least one of the members appointed by the President Pro  
24 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives shall be a resident within the boundaries of the  
2 Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning District as set forth  
3 in Section 83 of this title.
