Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma 18 Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative 19 referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and 20 addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to 21 the people for their approval or rejection at the General Election. 22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 70 of Title 25, unless there is 24 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. On November 8, 2022, the standard time in Oklahoma shall be 2 known as Central Standard Time. This section shall not be construed to affect the standard 3 В. 4 time established by United States law governing the movements of 5 common carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for performance of an act by an officer or department of the United 6 7 States, as established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an agency hereof. 8 C. As authorized by the Uniform Time Act of 1966, as amended, 10 and notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary by the United States government relating to adoption of daylight saving 11 12 time by all of the states, the State of Oklahoma elects to reject 1.3 such time and elects to continue in force the terms of subsection A 14 of this section relating to standard time in Oklahoma. 15 The rejection of daylight saving time as provided for in 16 this section may be changed by future legislative action. 17 SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed act shall be in 18 the following form: 19 BALLOT TITLE 20 Legislative Referendum No. State Question No. 21 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 22 The measure establishes that standard time in Oklahoma shall be

known as Central Standard Time. The measure rejects the

adoption of daylight saving time in this state and mandates the
