10 An Act relating to the Office of Management and  
11 Enterprise Services; requiring that certain  
12 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes in  
13 certain amounts for certain purposes; directing  
certain transfer; providing certain limitation on  
amount of transfer; providing lapse dates; and  
requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of  
18 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040  
19 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One  
20 Million Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$1,920,000.00) shall  
21 be used to provide for the Pay for Success program. Of that amount,  
22 seventy-five percent (75%) shall be utilized by the Office in equal  
23 amounts for municipalities of the state with populations of three

1 hundred fifty thousand (350,000) or more as determined by the latest  
2 Federal Decennial Census.

3 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of  
4 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040  
5 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
6 Fifteen Million Eight Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Six Hundred  
7 Sixty-six Dollars (\$15,847,666.00) shall be used to provide for  
8 Device-as-a-service augmentation.

9 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of  
10 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040  
11 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One  
12 Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used for  
13 the study of human trafficking performed by the Oklahoma Commission  
14 on the Status of Women.

15 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Office of  
16 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040  
17 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
18 Thirty-five Million Seven Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand Dollars  
19 (\$35,737,000.00) shall be used for Service Oklahoma implementation.

20 SECTION 5. The Director of the Office of Management and  
21 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies from the FY-22  
22 appropriation made to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board in an  
23 amount outlined in Section 100 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of  
24 the 1st Session of the 58th Legislature for costs associated with a

1 water study to the Phase II Arbuckle-Simpson Hydrology Study  
2 Revolving Fund (235 Fund) created pursuant to Section 1085.7C of  
3 Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Phase II of the Arbuckle-  
4 Simpson Hydrology Study except that the cumulative amounts  
5 transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amounts of equal monthly  
6 allotments of the appropriation made to the Oklahoma Water Resources  
7 Board.

8 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
9 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be  
11 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).  
12 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
13 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds  
14 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall  
15 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
16 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June  
17 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse  
18 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
19 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
20 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23 and not required to pay  
21 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after  
22 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
23 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds

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1 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been  
2 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
