12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2021, Section 3-107, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 3-107. A. There is hereby created and designated as a
15 facility within the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
16 Services ~~the Rose Rock Recovery Center~~ Transitions Recovery Center
17 at Vinita. The facility shall be operated under the supervision and
18 administration of the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance
19 Abuse Services. It is the intent of the Legislature that ~~the Rose~~
20 ~~Rock Recovery Center~~ Transitions Recovery Center at Vinita utilize
21 and receive business management, support services and medical
22 ancillary services of the Oklahoma Forensic Center.

23 B. There is hereby created a petty cash fund for ~~the Rose Rock~~
24 ~~Recovery Center~~ Transitions Recovery Center at Vinita. The Director

1 of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and the
2 Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services are
3 authorized to fix the maximum amount of the petty cash fund. The
4 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
5 prescribe the rules and procedures for the administration of the
6 petty cash fund.

7 C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
8 is authorized to effect the transfer of property, records,
9 equipment, supplies, funds and encumbrances from the Oklahoma
10 Forensic Center to or from ~~the Rose Rock Recovery Center~~ Transitions
11 Recovery Center at Vinita.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
