A new section of law to be codified 18 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-105 of Title 70, unless there 19 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: Notwithstanding any policy of a school athletic association, 21 as defined by Section 27-102 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 22 23 in all regular season high school athletic competitions in this 24 state, the visiting team shall have the same rights to radio

- B. The provisions of this section shall apply to athletic competitions beginning in the 2021-2022 school year.
- C. The provisions of this section shall apply to contracts for the rights to radio broadcast, video stream and provide telegraphic play-by-play accounts entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of this act.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
