22 John L. Hayden Memorial Highway; designating the
Creede Speake Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the
23 W.D. Bill Amis Memorial Bridge; designating the SSG
Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway; designating the
24 Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge; designating the Martin
Dyer Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Craig

1 Johnson Memorial Highway; designating the U.S.
2 Senator James Inhofe Interchange; designating the
3 Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway; amending Section 11,
4 Chapter 369, O.S.L. 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section
5 1698.296), which relates to the Councilwoman Avalon
6 Reese Memorial Highway; modifying name of certain
7 memorial highway; providing for codification; and
8 providing an effective date.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located
14 approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be
15 designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert
16 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of
17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
18 name to be placed on the bridge.

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located
23 approximately one-half (0.5) mile north of West Madison Avenue near
24 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the
"U.S. Army PFC Keith N. Cantrell Memorial Bridge". The Department

1 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
2 that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of
7 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of
8 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be
9 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr., and Michael Rogers Memorial
10 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
11 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located
16 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal
17 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran
18 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
19 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
20 bridge.

21 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County beginning at the
2 intersection of Newman Road then extending north to the intersection
3 of Commerce Street in the City of Commerce shall be designated as
4 "South Mickey Mantle Boulevard". The Department of Transportation
5 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
6 placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Deep Rock Road and
11 extending north three (3) miles in Payne County shall be designated
12 as the "Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway". The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
14 name to be placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over
19 South 129th Avenue on State Highway 51, also known as the Broken
20 Arrow Expressway, in Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, shall be designated
21 as the "Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
23 name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over Lee
5 Boulevard on Interstate 44 in the City of Lawton in Comanche County
6 shall be designated as the "Maj. Charles E. Stiles Memorial Bridge".
7 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
8 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

9 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
13 Highway 28A beginning at the intersection of State Highway 66 near
14 the Town of Foyil extending east to the intersection of Interstate
15 44 in Rogers County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H.
16 Honeycutt Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
17 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
18 the highway.

19 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge crossing over the Washita River on U.S. Highway 62
23 located three-tenths (0.3) of a mile east of the H.E. Bailey
24 Turnpike near Chickasha in Grady County shall be designated as the

1 "Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher Memorial Bridge". The Department of
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
3 name to be placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge crossing
8 over the Washita River on State Highway 8 north of the city of
9 Anadarko in Caddo County shall be designated as the "Joe W. McBride
10 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
11 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
12 bridge.

13 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of the U.S. Highway 70 Bypass beginning just south
17 of U.S. 70 and extending south and west to the intersection of
18 McLean Drive on the west side of the city of Durant in Bryan County
19 shall be designated as the "Deputy Jarid Taylor Memorial Highway".
20 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
21 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 78 beginning just north of the
2 intersection of State Highway 22 extending northwesterly to the
3 eastern municipal limits of Milburn in Johnston County shall be
4 designated as the "USAF Capt. Nick Karpis Vietnam Veteran Memorial
5 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
6 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the north municipal
11 limits of Mill Creek in Johnston County then extending northerly to
12 the Murray County line shall be designated as the "Sgt. Clyde Runyan
13 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
14 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
15 highway.

16 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The causeway over Old Spiro Lake on State Highway 9 in LeFlore
20 County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Maj. Marvail Lewis Memorial
21 Causeway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
22 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the causeway.

1 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the intersection of
5 E1040 Road extending northerly to the intersection of E. 128th
6 Street in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "County
7 Commissioner Roy Rains Memorial Highway". The Department of
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
9 name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the intersection of
14 U.S. Highway 75 extending east two (2) miles to the intersection of
15 N. Memorial Road in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "PFC
16 Richard Tafoya Gurule Memorial Highway". The Department of
17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
18 name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of State Highway 9 beginning at the intersection of
23 Interstate 35 extending west to the intersection of U.S. Highway 62
24 in McClain County shall be designated as the "Capt. David Arthur

1 Peters Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
3 the highway.

4 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.326 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The intersection of State Highway 66 and Banner Road in Canadian
8 County shall be designated as the "Ray Davis Memorial Intersection".
9 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
10 markers bearing that name to be placed at the intersection.

11 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.327 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of State Highway 25 beginning at the intersection of
15 State Highway 2 extending east to the western municipal limits of
16 Bluejacket in Craig County shall be designated as the "Robert L.
17 Horton Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
18 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
19 the highway.

20 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.328 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of State Highway 3 West beginning at the west side
24 of the State Highway 19 interchange extending west to the

1 intersection of County Road 1510 in Pontotoc County shall be
2 designated as the "John L. Hayden Memorial Highway". The Department
3 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
4 that name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.329 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
9 Highway 53 beginning at the intersection of Midway Road extending
10 east through the community of Milo to the intersection of Woodford
11 Road in Carter County shall be designated as the "Creede Speake Jr.
12 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
13 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
14 highway.

15 SECTION 23. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.330 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The bridge over Honey Creek Pass located on Interstate 35 just
19 south of Exit 51 in Murray County shall be designated as the "W.D.
20 Bill Amis Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
21 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
22 the bridge.

1 SECTION 24. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.331 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 199 from the western municipal
5 limits of Dickson to the eastern municipal limits of Ardmore shall
6 be designated as the "SSG Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

9 SECTION 25. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.332 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge crossing over US Highway 69 Business located on US
13 Highway 69 at the south edge of McAlester in Pittsburg County shall
14 be designated as the "Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge". The
15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
16 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

17 SECTION 26. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.333 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of U.S.
21 Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of Broadway Avenue in
22 Ardmore extending north to the intersection of State Highway 142 in
23 Carter County shall be designated as the "Martin Dyer Memorial
24

1 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 27. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
4 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.334 of Title 69, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of U.S. Highway 169 beginning at the intersection of
7 East 81st Street South extending north to the south side of State
8 Highway 51 in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Craig
9 Johnson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
11 the highway.

12 SECTION 28. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.335 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the interchange of
16 Interstate 40 and Douglas Boulevard located in Midwest City in
17 Oklahoma County shall be designated as the "U.S. Senator James
18 Inhofe Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause
19 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at the
20 interchange.

21 SECTION 29. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.336 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at the intersection of
2 N3990 Road extending east through the town of Morris to the
3 intersection of N4030 Road in Okmulgee County shall be designated as
4 the "Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway". The Department of
5 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
6 name to be placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 30. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L.
8 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1698.296), is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 Section 1698.296 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business
11 beginning at West 23rd Street South extending north to the
12 intersection of West Southside Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in
13 Muskogee County shall be designated as the "Councilwoman Avalon
14 ~~Reese~~ Reece Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
15 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
16 placed on the highway.

17 SECTION 31. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
