14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-162 of Title 37A, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	Retail spirit licensees may operate and sell alcoholic
19	beverages, including beer, wine and spirits, in sealed original
20	containers to consumers aged twenty-one (21) years and older, with a
21	valid state- or government-issued ID, via a drive-thru window.
22	Orders of beer, wine and spirits to be picked up via a drive-
23	thru window may be purchased by consumers by:
24	1. Ordering in person and paying at the drive-thru window;

1	2. Ordering by phone and paying at the drive-thru window; or
2	3. Ordering online and paying either online or at the drive-
3	thru window.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
