17	service that a motor license agent licensed operator is authorized
18	to provide pursuant to the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration
19	Act there shall include a step where the individual shall select a
20	motor license agent licensed operator in the state to process any
21	online transaction.
22	Said The motor license agent as defined in Section 1102 of this
23	title does not include the Oklahoma Tax Commission Service Oklahoma.
