7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to prevention and control of disease;  
9 prohibiting entering of immunization records or other  
10 data into certain database or system without informed  
11 consent; prohibiting sharing of immunization records  
12 or other data without informed consent; providing for  
deletion and destruction of immunization records and  
other data of minor child upon request; providing for  
codification; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The State Department of Health or an agent of the Department  
19 shall not enter immunization records or other data of an individual  
20 into any database or system including, but not limited to, the  
21 Oklahoma State Immunization Information System without the prior  
22 written informed consent of the individual or, in the case of a  
23 minor child, the prior written informed consent of the minor child's  
24 parent or guardian.

1 B. The State Department of Health or an agent of the Department  
2 shall not share any immunization records or other data of an  
3 individual entered into any database or system including, but not  
4 limited to, the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System  
5 including but not limited to immunization records or immunization  
6 status, with a health care provider or health insurer without the  
7 prior written informed consent of the individual or, in the case of  
8 a minor child, the prior written informed consent of the minor  
9 child's parent or guardian.

10 C. If a parent or guardian has granted informed consent to the  
11 entering of immunization records or other data of such parent or  
12 guardian's minor child into any database or system including, but  
13 not limited to, the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System,  
14 the parent or guardian may, at any time, request the deletion of all  
15 immunization records or other data of the minor child from the  
16 system. Upon receipt of such a request, the Department shall  
17 promptly delete all immunization records and other data of the minor  
18 child from the system and shall delete or destroy any other files or  
19 records of the minor child stored by the Department.

20 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
