SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 10

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; changing the percentage of legal voters from statewide to every congressional district of the state for certain petitions; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the initiative, and eight per centum percent (8%) of the legal voters of every congressional district of this state shall have the right to propose any legislative measure, and fifteen per centum percent (15%) of the legal voters of every congressional district of this state shall have the right to propose amendments to the Constitution

1	by petition, and every such petition shall include the full text of
2	the measure so proposed. The second power is the referendum, and it
3	may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for the immediate
4	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety), either by
5	petition signed by five per centum <u>percent (5%)</u> of the legal voters
6	of every congressional district of this state or by the Legislature
7	as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per centum <u>percentage</u> of
8	legal voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the total
9	number of votes cast at the last general election for the Office of
10	Governor.
11	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
12	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
13	the following form:

16	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
17	This measure amends Section 2 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma
18	Constitution. It amends a section pertaining to initiative and
19	referendum petitions. The amendment changes the percentage of
