7	An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; amending Section 14, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2016, as last amended
8	by Section 3, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2019 (37A O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 2-102), which relates to brewer
9	and small brewer licenses; authorizing holders of multiple small brewer licenses to sell beer at
10	multiple locations; and providing an effective date.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
15	2016, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2019 (37A
16	O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 2-102), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 2-102. A. A brewer license shall authorize the holder
18	thereof:
19	1. To manufacture, bottle, package and store beer and cider on
20	the licensed premises; and
21	2. To sell beer and cider in this state to holders of beer
22	distributor licenses and to sell beer and cider out of this state to
23	qualified persons.
24	B. A small brewer license shall authorize the holder thereof:

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To manufacture, bottle, package and store beer produced by
 the licensee on licensed premises;

3 2. To sell beer in this state to holders of beer distributor
4 licenses and retail licenses or to sell beer out of this state to
5 qualified persons;

3. To serve free samples of beer produced by the licensee to
visitors twenty-one (21) years of age or older;

8 4. To sell beer produced by the licensee for either on-premises
9 or off-premises consumption to consumers on the brewery premises, or
10 on premises located contiguous thereto;

11 5. To sell beer at public events such as trade shows or 12 festivals;

13 6. To purchase wine in retail containers from the holder of a14 wholesaler license or as specifically provided by law; and

15 7. To sell, offer for sale and possess wine for on-premises16 consumption.

17 C. <u>The holder of multiple small brewer licenses may sell beer</u> 18 <u>produced at any brewery for which the licensee has a license at any</u> 19 <u>other brewery for which the licensee has a license, or on premises</u> 20 located contiguous thereto.

<u>D.</u> Nothing in this act the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control
 <u>Act</u> shall prohibit the holder of a small brewer license from also
 holding or owning an interest in the holder of a brewpub license.

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1 D. E. For purposes of this section, no visitor may sample more 2 than a total of twelve (12) fluid ounces of beer per day. The brewer must restrict the distribution and consumption of beer 3 4 samples to an area within the licensed premises designated by the 5 brewer. A current floor plan that includes the designated sampling area must be on file with the ABLE Commission. No visitor under 6 7 twenty-one (21) years of age shall be permitted to enter this designated sampling area when samples are being distributed or 8 9 consumed. Samples of beer served by a brewery under this section 10 shall not be considered a sale of beer within the meaning of Article 11 XXVIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution or Section 1-103 of this 12 title; however, such samples of beer shall be considered beer 13 removed or withdrawn from the brewery for use or consumption within 14 the meaning of Section 5-110 of this title for excise tax 15 determination and reporting requirements. Sales and sampling may 16 only occur between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m.

17 E. F. A small brewer self-distribution license shall authorize 18 holders of a small brewer license to distribute beer produced only 19 by such licensee to a holder of a retail beer license, retail 20 spirits license, mixed beverage license, beer and wine license, 21 caterer's license, special event license, public event license, 22 charitable auction license or brewpub license. A small brewer shall 23 elect whether it will distribute through a distributor or self-24 distribute in a subject territory; however, a small brewer may not

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elect to do both simultaneously in a subject territory. The election shall be made through notice to the ABLE Commission. Any changes to the election shall require immediate notification to the ABLE Commission before the change in election will take effect. A small brewer that elects to self-distribute in multiple territories shall only be required to have one small brewer self-distribution license.

8 F. G. All manufacturer's licenses held by brewers during the 9 first calendar year beginning October 1, 2018, shall automatically 10 convert to brewer licenses and be deemed effective as of the date of 11 the first issuance of the manufacturer's license. Upon the first 12 renewal of said license, the brewer will need to obtain the 13 appropriate brewer's license. If a brewer elects to market wine and 14 spirits, the brewer will also be required to obtain a manufacturer's 15 license and comply with the rules and regulations for both licenses. 16 SECTION 2.
