6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; allowing caretaker of a  
8 child in a safety plan to consent to certain  
9 examinations of the child; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-3-104 of Title 10A, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The caretaker of a child who is in a safety plan with the  
16 Department of Human Services may, if the parent of the child is  
17 unwilling or unavailable, authorize:

18 1. Medical or dental treatment or examinations which are  
19 necessary for the wellbeing of the child; and

20 2. Medical or forensic examinations which could reveal evidence  
21 of a crime committed against the child.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
