15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1919.1 of Title 63, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Except as provided by Section 10-111 of Title 43A of the
19	Oklahoma statutes, every long-term care facility must provide
20	immediate access to a resident by immediate family and other
21	relatives of the resident, subject to the resident's right to deny
22	or withdraw consent at any time.
23	B. Every long-term care facility must provide reasonable access

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to a resident by health care providers who are contracted with the

facility to provide such care, subject to the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent at any time. C. Visitation and access described in subsections A and B of this section may be subject to reasonable clinical and safety restrictions as ordered by the State Department of Health. D. No long-term care facility shall unilaterally eliminate visitation for any reason. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021. 58-1-5902 01/08/21 AB 

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
