16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2005 of Title 56, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	Applications for Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver
21	Services for the Community Waiver, In-Home Supports Waiver for
22	Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children operated by the
23	Department of Human Services shall not be made until an applicant
24	has been a resident of Oklahoma for five (5) years prior to the date

of application. The Department of Human Services shall promulgate rules as necessary for the implementation and administration of the provisions of this section. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 58-1-8306 05/14/21 MKS
