Research Analysis

The Senate Amendment to HB 1149 requires persons engaged in the activities of a used motor vehicle sales to obtain a certificate of registration from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission. The measure provides that the cost of any administrative fine is to be borne by the employing entity. A salesperson is deemed to be temporarily approved and allowed to sell vehicles when applications and fees are on file with the Commission. The measure authorizes a person to sell used motor vehicles without obtaining a separate used motor vehicle salesperson's certificate of registration if the person has a certificate of registration from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission to sell new or unused motor vehicles at a new motor vehicle dealer's licensed franchise location which also sells used vehicles. The cost of the registration for each sales person is \$50 to be renewed biennially and may be transferred for a fee of \$25. The measure also requires new recreational vehicle manufacturer, factory representative to obtain licensure from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies several provisions of the statutes related to motor vehicle salespersons, including undertaking sales activities without proper registration. The provisions of the measure will have no impact on agency revenue or operations costs. The measure clarifies and corrects certain changes to the statutes enacted in 2019.
