Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1663 provides that when any portion of a dedicated road, street, or highway touches the municipal limits of a city or town, the entire portion of the dedicated road, street, or highway shall form the boundary line for the purposes of enforcing traffic regulations and ordinances.
