Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1751 modifies the declaration of candidacy process to include that the candidate must provide the date the candidate registered as a voter of their political party, their voter registration identification number, and, in an oath, the voter must also affirm they reside at the current address listed in the Declaration of Candidacy form. If a candidate provides an address that is not their principal residence, they shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
