Research Analysis

HB 1751 modifies the declaration of candidacy process to include that in the oath of qualification for candidacy, the candidate swears or affirms that they reside at the current address listed on the Declaration of Candidacy form. If a candidate provides an address that is not their principal residence, they shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).
