**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB1751 adds the requirement that when a candidate is filling out a declaration of candidacy form, they must include their current political party affiliation, the date in which they registered with that party, and previous county and date of party affiliation, if the date on the form is six months or less immediately preceding the first day of the filing period.

The committee substitute to HB 1751 modifies the declaration of candidacy process to include that the candidate must provide the date they registered as a voter of their political party, their voter registration identification number, and in an oath, the voter must also affirm they reside at the current address listed in the Declaration of Candidacy form. If a candidate provides an address that is not their principal residence, they shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00)
