Research Analysis

The committee amendment to HB1775 clarifies that the Emergency Action Plan shall assign a medical administrator who is a current school employee. It also clarifies that the defibrillator should only be listed in the Emergency Action Plan if it is available.

The amendment removes the requirement that Emergency Action Plan be included in a district's accreditation file.

Lastly the amendment requires the Emergency Action Plan to be digitally transmitted to any visiting team's coach or administrator before the game or event.
