**Research Analysis**

HB1775, as introduced, updates the requirements for “Riley’s Rule”.

The measure requires school boards to coordinate with the emergency medical providers in their area to create an Emergency Action Plan for all athletic events and facilities.

The Action Plan shall:

- Include maps and directions with appropriate contact information for emergency medical services
- Assign a medical administrator
- Define responsibilities for both medical and school officials
- Include a list of medical equipment available, and the location of the nearest defibrillator
- Be distributed to all school officials involved in athletic activities
- Be rehearsed annually, prior to the start of the season, with school officials and local emergency medical providers
- Be reviewed in a medical time out prior to each athletic event where there are athletes from a visiting team
