Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB1775 strikes the title, enacting clause, the entire bill and inserts language prohibiting state colleges and universities from requiring gender or sexual diversity training or counseling. Voluntary counseling shall not be prohibited.

The amendment also prohibits school employees from incorporating certain messages about sex and race into any course instruction.

Fiscal Analysis

The prohibition relates to certain training or counseling. To the extent such activities currently occur and costs may have been associated there may be nominal savings. No reliable data can be identified to provide analysis, although no measureable impact is anticipated.

While the measure is not expected to result in a negative fiscal impact on state appropriations, there may be some revenue considerations for certain public entities.
