Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB 1784 adjusts the penalties for violation of the provisions of the measure. Previously, a vendor found in violation would be, upon conviction, guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in a county jail for up to one year, a fine of up to \$1,000 or both. In the amended measure, the misdemeanor is punishable by a fine of up to \$500 for a first offense and up to \$1,000 for a second offense. Upon conviction for a third offense, the vendor shall be prohibited from selling kratom products for three years. A vendor found to be selling kratom products during the period of suspension shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in a county jail for up to one year, a fine of up to \$2,000 or both.
