Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1800 extends the time period a person discharged from the military is eligible for in-state tuition at a state college or university. Currently, a person who was discharged from the military within the past 5 years is eligible for in-state tuition. HB 3367 extends that to 10 years. The measure also allows any member of the Armed Forces who was stationed in Oklahoma for more than one year at any time in the previous ten years to be eligible for in-state tuition. These provisions also apply to the person's spouse and dependent.
