HB 1845 requires an operator of a motor vehicle to operate the vehicle with their headlights on at all times during conditions of rain.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1845, as introduced, would require the use of vehicle headlamps at all times during conditions of rain while on highways within the state. The measure further provides that if a vehicle's windshield wipers are on, the vehicle's headlamps shall also be on.

By adding an instance where motorists might be issued a citation, the measure could potentially increase fine revenues for the state. An exact impact would depend on the number of citations issued.
