**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB1882 strikes the title, enacting clause, entire bill and inserts language creating the “Out of Schooltime Task Force” which will:

- Identify and evaluate a set of evidence-based best practices to improve and increase the number of quality, affordable out-of-school programs,
- Review tools to evaluate success across education,
- Explore funding sources to support out of school time.
