**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1892 creates the 12-member Advisory Task Force on Prevention of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation. The Task Force is to study human trafficking, prostitution and child exploitation in Oklahoma and make recommendations to the Legislature on methods and laws to enhance and fund the efforts of law enforcement or community groups that are working to slow and stop prostitution, human trafficking or child exploitation. The Task Force is also to develop methods to assist in identifying and interrupting websites that promote pornography and sexually explicit materials and develop methods to support community groups working with victims of human trafficking, prostitution or child exploitation.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1892 creates the Advisory Task Force on Prevention of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation.

Staffing of the task force shall be jointly shared by the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives.

Overall costs of the task force are expected to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgetary resources.
