Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB 1892 creates the 13-member Advisory Task Force on Prevention of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation. The Task Force is to study human trafficking, prostitution and child exploitation in Oklahoma and make recommendations to the Legislature on methods and laws to enhance and fund the efforts of law enforcement or community groups that are working to slow and stop prostitution, human trafficking or child exploitation. The Task Force is to submit a report of findings and recommendations on or before February 1, 2022 at which time the Advisory Task Force terminates.
