**Research Analysis**

HB 1903 allows the director of the Department of Corrections to request that the executive director of the Pardon and Parole Board place a medically frail or medically vulnerable inmate on the parole docket. The measure provides definitions.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure modifies the definition of inmates of the Department of Corrections that are eligible for medical parole review to include those that are medically frail or medically vulnerable as certified by the medical director of the DOC.

Upon review and with consultation from the DOC, the measure has an unknown impact. The measure provides structure for the DOC's determination of inmates eligible for medical parole. However, the medical parole process is completed so rarely and requires approval from the Pardon and Parole Review Board and the Governor that the DOC is unable to estimate the fiscal impact of the measure.
