Research Analysis

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1925 allows mail-order pharmacies to be used to meet access standards for retail pharmacy networks. In relation to retail pharmacy network access standards, compliance review, and health insurer's duty to monitor certain activities and ensure compliance, the measure provides an exception if certain entities require the use of a mail-order pharmacy as a condition of prescription drug coverage. The measure allows a health insurer or pharmacy benefits manager (PBM) to enact certain requirements and incentives from an individual's choice of in-network pharmacy.
