HB 1963 modifies the rules for appointing school board members to state that if a majority of members in a school district or technology center school district are lost, the Governor shall appoint enough members to reach a quorum to the board of education. The appointment will be consistent with existing requirements and only for the remainder of the term of office.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1963 in its current form, requires the Governor to make appointments for board of education board vacancies that result in a loss of a majority of the board. Officials for the State Election Board (SEB) do not anticipate a fiscal impact for SEB or county election boards as a result of the provisions of HB 1963.
