Research Analysis

HB 2010 defines the following terms: mobile food establishment; mobile push cart; mobile retail food establishment; mobile food vendor; mobile food vending; food vending vehicle; local authority; public property; temporary mass gathering; and nonobstructive spot inspection. The measure modifies the rule requiring the State Department of Health to charge and collect an annual fee for food establishment licensure.

The measure requires mobile food vendors to follow all state and local laws guiding operations. A mobile food vendor is authorized to operate in certain locations in a certain manner. The measure authorizes the State Department of Health to promulgate rules for enforcement. The adoption of rules by the State Department of Health have certain restrictions. The measure authorizes local authorities to regulate mobile food vendors with certain restrictions.

The measure allows for an administrative hearing for any mobile food vendor who has been notified of a suspension or revocation of license. The State Department of Health is authorized to issue penalties to mobile food vendors who are without, suspended, or revoked of license. The measure provides an appeals process. The measure clarifies law in relation to this act.
