HB 2027 allows a licensed attorney to bypass the security checkpoint in a facility that houses a district court upon presentation of an identification card showing active membership in the Oklahoma Bar Association and proof of identity to the security staff present at the checkpoint, unless that person will knowingly have direct contact with a criminal defendant currently in the custody of the state.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2027, as introduced, provides that attorneys licensed to practice law in Oklahoma may bypass security checkpoints at district court locations upon presenting an identification card showing active membership in the Oklahoma Bar Association and proof of identity unless the attorney will knowingly have direct contact with a criminal defendant currently in the custody of the state.

No state fiscal or revenue considerations are presented by passage of the measure.
