**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2319 directs the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative shall design and implement a plan for a statewide interoperable radio communications system. The Cooperative is to develop the plan and its implementation in collaboration with all state agencies, political subdivision entities and other interested parties that manage or maintain a public safety radio system in this state and submit the plan by November 1, 2022. The measure creates a the Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Revolving Fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2319 directs the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative to design and implement a plan for a statewide interoperable radio communications system in collaboration with state agencies, political subdivision entities, and other interested parties.

The measure also establishes the new Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Revolving Fund to be expended by the Office of Emergency Management to award grants by and through the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative.
