Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2319 directs the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative shall design and implement a plan for a statewide interoperable radio communications system. The Cooperative is to develop the plan and its implementation in collaboration with all state agencies, political subdivision entities and other interested parties that manage or maintain a public safety radio system in this state and submit the plan by November 1, 2022. The measure creates a the Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Revolving Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2319 creates a new revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (OEM) to be designated the “Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Revolving Fund”.

Designated deposits to the fund may be budgeted and expended by OEM for the purpose of awarding grants by and through the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative for the purpose of implementing and maintaining a statewide interoperable radio communications system.

The measure directs the Cooperative to design and implement a plan for a statewide interoperable radio communications system. The Cooperative shall also submit to the Governor, the Speaker of the House, the Pro Tem of the Senate, and the chairs of appropriate legislative committees a plan that includes any funding necessary to implement and maintain the system.

The exact impact of the measure is under review and will be completed.
