The Senate amendments to HB2396 authorize non-profit organizations to provide a series of in-depth sex trafficking prevention and education programs to freshman students at state colleges and universities. The nonprofits must specialize in outreach and education programs on sex trafficking.

State colleges and universities are required to provide freshman students the opportunity to attend one of three of these programs during freshman orientation.
