**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute (PCS) to HB 2441 clarifies when an abortion is prohibited. The PCS prohibits an abortion when an unborn child has been determined to have a detectable heartbeat. The PCS defines the term “detectable heartbeat.” The PCS clarifies and provides the exception for when an abortion can proceed.

The PCS requires posting certain information on signage about abortions that are induced using a two-step process which maybe reversible if the second step has not been taken.
