Fiscal Analysis

HB 2868, as introduced, provides that retail spirit licensees may sell alcoholic beverages, including beer, wine, and spirits, through a drive-thru window to customers 21 years and older with a valid state- or government-issued ID.

By expanding the scope of retail spirit license operations, there may be an increase in demand for retail spirit licenses. The state could potentially realize increased revenues from an increase in retail spirit licenses issued.
