Fiscal Analysis

The measure authorizes the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to execute federal loans through the Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (U.S.C., Sections 601-609) in an amount not to exceed \$200,000,000. Service on the loan or loans will depend on the structure of any loan, including amounts, interest provisions and duration of any loan.
