Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB2899 states that applications for Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Services for the Community Waiver, In-Home Supports Waiver for Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children operated by the Department of Human Services cannot be made until the applicant has been an Oklahoma resident for 5 years prior to the application date. The Department of Human Services shall promulgate rules necessary for implementation and administration.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2899 would limit the new applicants from Department of Human Services' Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Services for Community, In-Home Supports Waiver for Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children. The measure puts in place a 5-year waiting period for new residents. Such limitation is likely to limit cost growth for the listed programs.
